The plaintiff was a driver who was T-boned by a tractor-trailer owned and operated by a national company. The plaintiff was transported by helicopter from the scene. The plaintiff was treated and released from Norfolk Sentara emergency room and later admitted to John Randolph Hospital.

The plaintiff subsequently was seen by a family physician and was referred for a neuropsychological exam and was evaluated with mild traumatic brain injury. The defense medical exam confirmed mild traumatic brain injury.

The case settled after one day of mediation.
